I understand that if any future academic violation charge is filed against me by any faculty member while I am attending Seaver College, the level of the new violation will be increased as follows: (1) a second instance of a Level One violation will become an automatic Level Two or higher violation; (2) a second instance of a Level Two violation will become an automatic Level Two violation will become an automatic Level Three or higher violation. I understand that by selecting "Request Hearing," I am stating that I do not agree with the professor's judgment of this incident and/or the sanction that the professor has imposed, and I wish to have a hearing with the Academic Integrity Committee.

I understand that the committee will make its determination according to the "preponderance of the evidence" (that is, whether it is more likely than not that the student has violated the academic integrity code).

I acknowledge that it is possible that the committee may find that a higher level violation has occurred and/or that a more severe sanction should be imposed.
