

**COURSE INFORMATION FALL & SPRING 2009-2010
FLORENCE RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM**

Pepperdine Visiting Faculty Member: Dr. Ron Cox, Assistant Professor of Religion

Prerequisite: Students must meet all prerequisite requirements for each course they intend on taking overseas. Waivers cannot be issued for students to take courses without meeting prerequisite requirements. Prerequisites are found in the Seaver Academic Catalog: <http://seaver.pepperdine.edu/academics/catalog/>.

General Requirements: While studying in the Florence Program, all students must enroll in 12-18 units including an Italian course each semester for a letter grade. Students must complete ITAL 151 or its equivalent by the end of the Spring 2009 semester to participate. Students participating in the Spring Only 2010 semester must complete ITAL 152 by the end of the Fall 2008 semester. There is an additional fee associated with PE courses.

Students will register for their Fall Florence courses online in March during Fall 2009 registration. Students will register for their Spring Florence courses online in November during Spring 2010 registration. Please check your Pepperdine email for your exact registration time.
