As the anniversary of the Borderline Shooting and Woolsey Fire approaches this week, the following events are open to the Pepperdine community to come together in prayer and healing.

- During Wednesday Chapel on **November 6 at 10 AM** in Firestone Fieldhouse, the community will pause for a moment of prayer for each tragedy and welcome a panel who will speak on resilience and suffering.
- On **November 7 at 4:30 PM** the Pepperdine community will gather in the first-floor lobby of the Thornton Administrative Center as we remember Alaina Housley and dedicate a tree in her memory. Immediately following the dedication, the Student Government Association has invited all faculty to participate in the students' healing process with a community meal in Waves Cafe. - On **November 8** the University will celebrate Hope Forward Day with Sacred Yoga at 9 AM on the Sandbar Patio, Celebration Chapel at 10 AM, and a Hope Forward wellness fair from 11 AM to 2 PM during which faculty may contribute to "The Hope Forward Quilt of Care," a commemorative art piece.
