- Tuesday, October 22 at 2 PM in BPC 188

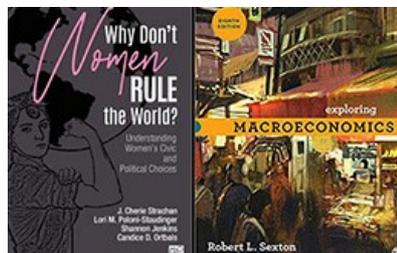
