Are you looking for ways to improve your Navigate experience? Kelle Marshall, Navigate super user and associate professor of French, shares her tip:



“The **calendar sync** option in Navigate is useful in documenting how much time I spend advising students in-person. When advising a student, I open up their page on Navigate and open a new appointment report. In the report, I log the exact time of the beginning of the appointment. When I close the report at the end of the session, it syncs into my Google calendar allowing me to tangibly record the hours spent on in-person advising—a previously difficult metric to track.”


