

## Requirements for Admission to the Business Administration Division as a Contract Finance Major

A student will be considered for admission to the Business Administration Division after completion of 48 units of work with no grade below a C- in any of the required courses below and an overall grade point average of 2.5 in all classes taken.

The following courses must be part of the 48 units needed for admission to the program, and a grade of a C- or better is required in each course: (\*\*NOTE: a grade of a B or better is required in BA 321)
