Application Deadline: March 16, 2009 (application fee required)

***Materials must be postmarked by the deadline*

Eligibility:

- Successful completion of 60 units including Psychology 200, Sociology 200, or equivalent
- Good academic standing at a university
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

The Pepperdine Undergraduate Certificate in Conflict Management uses a self-managed application process. Please complete all the requested materials and send together in a single packet. Items such as references and transcripts should be included in the packet unopened. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Completed Application. Type or print in black ink. If you need more room, please feel free to use additional paper and simply attach them to the completed application form.

Attachments. Essay and short answer should be typed and attached to the completed application form.

\$40 Non-refundable Application Fee. (check or money order made payable to Pepperdine University). Print your name and Undergraduate Conflict Management Program on the check or money order. Application fee waived for students who apply for *Early Decision*. These must be postmarked by February 15.

Two References. Two faculty references are required. Printable reference forms are available on the website (seaver.pepperdine.edu/summerschool/). Ask your references to seal their recommendation in an envelope and sign his or her name across the flap. Include the sealed reference with your application packet

An Official College Transcript. Please include your official transcript in a sealed envelope along with other application materials. Transcripts in a language other than English must also be official and must be accompanied by an official English translation.
