

2021 Instructions for applying to the Pepperdine University ISPP program

Please see the information below that details the application process to Pepperdine University's ISPP program. If you have any other specific questions, please email the director.

Phase II Applications

Beginning **Thursday, April 8th** you may apply to the Pepperdine ISPP through DICAS. Once this application has been reviewed, you will receive an email notifying you that it has been received and you may be given an opportunity to set up an interview.

In addition to any materials submitted through DICAS, **Pepperdine University requires an application be submitted directly through the University.** Please go to the link below and you will find an "APPLY NOW" button that will take you to the application. This does not have to be received prior to notification of an interview.

The supplemental materials required for the application are:

- 1) Updated Transcripts
- 2) Letters of recommendation- **Please note:** the Pepperdine application requires you to enter emails -if you **do not plan on submitting different letters** than those found in DICAS, enter my email in the space: sunnie.delano@pepperdine.edu. This will let the admissions office know you do not require additional letters.
- 3) Verification letter from DPD program and,
- 4) Proof that you did not match through DICAS (this can be a screen shot of the notice). This can be added under DICAS or the Pepperdine application as attachments.

*If you applied to the national match this year, you have these supplemental materials through DICAS. If you apply to our program through DICAS we will access these materials and transfer them to your Pepperdine file and **you do not need to submit the supplemental materials again.**

We will be accepting applications until **all spots are filled**. We are accepting up to 12 interns this year.
