Provider: Source, Benefactor, and Supplier

You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies. You honor me by anointing my head with oil. *My cup overflows with blessings*. (Psalm 23:5)

Praise:

Genesis 22:13 -14 Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him *was* a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of the place, *The-Lord-Will-Provide*; as it is said *to* this day, *"In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided."*

Romans 8:32 *He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all*—how will he not also, along with him, *graciously give us all things*?

Ephesians 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

Philippians 4:19 And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

Revelation 3:18 I counsel you to *buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich*; and white garments, that you may be clothed, *that* the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and *anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see*.

Isaiah 50:11 But now, *all you who light fires and provide yourselves* with flaming torches, go, *walk in the light of your fires* and of the torches you have set ablaze. This is what you shall receive from my hand: You will lie down in torment.

Luke 12:33 Sell your possessions and give to the poor. *Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven* that will never fail, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys.

Thanksgiving:

Romans 11:22 <u>Consider</u> therefore the kindness and sternness of God: sternness to those who fell, but *kindness to you, provided that you continue in his kindness*. Otherwise, you also will be cut off.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. *And God is faithful;* he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, *he will also provide* a way out so that you can endure it.

1 Corinthians 2:9 However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived *what God* has prepared for those who love him"—

Acts 14:17 Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown kindness by giving you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons; *he provides you with plenty* of food and fills your hearts with joy."
