Overview

The Malibu Gathering Church exists to share the renewing grace of the gospel by equipping and encouraging people to live in Christ, with community, for others. The purpose of the Ministry Intern position is first to provide an opportunity for an individual interested in ministry to explore first-hand the various areas of tangible, relational, and administrative ministry that occur within the Malibu Gathering community. Secondly, it will allow for the opportunity for the leadership at the Malibu Gathering to encourage and pour into the spiritual life of the individual. This position will report to various leaders throughout the church depending on the area of focus.

Qualifications

- An authentic relationship with Jesus Christ that is lived out with a sincere desire to follow Him in every area of life.
- An active commitment to the gospel and its power through the Word and the Spirit.
- Agreement with the theological statement of faith of the Malibu Gathering.
- Pepperdine undergraduate or graduate student studying within the Religion Division.
- An individual who is self-motivated, teachable, responsible, patient, kind, and driven to make a spiritual impact.
- One academic or professional reference and one personal reference (should be able to speak to the individual's spiritual life).

Responsibilities/Compensation:

- Commit to attending at least 3 of 4 Sundays per month at the Malibu Gathering.
 - 8:30am-12:30pm (set-up through take-down)
- Spend 3-4 weeks with each area of ministry identified based on individuals' preferences and skills.
 - Specific tasks may include helping with weekly set-up and take-down, yearly retreat planning, organizing children's ministry teaching schedule, assisting with orchestrating youth ministry events, creating marketing materials and infographics, etc.
- Attend events as able outside of Sunday morning that are relevant to the different ministry areas (i.e. youth events, Sunday school volunteer meeting, church family dinners).
- Meet biweekly with Student Ministry and Administrative Director as a personal check-in.
- \$400 Semester Stipend (First Week of September-First Week of December)
