

## **Youth Intern May 2020 to August 2020 Outline**

This is an opportunity for you to gain practical ministry experience, to work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support, to test your gifts and call to vocational ministry, and to develop spiritually. For the church, you bring practical help and energy to our youth ministry, provide spiritual guidance to the teens as well as model what a disciple of Christ's life looks like.

You will work under the guidance of Jim Oliver and Andrew Hill, meeting once a week with them. You will meet with the Elders at least the 1st Tuesday of the month, and more can be arranged as deemed necessary.

### Goals

Develop a small group/discipleship group.

At least once a week, a small group with our teens and their parents. This can be a game night with a devotional or a bible study with our teens and their parents.

### Develop service events with our youth

We would like to see our teens serving others in our community.

### Participate in VBS and YBC (camp)

### Speaking/Teaching

Speak one Sunday morning and speak twice Sunday evening. Teaching or assisting in classes as needed.

### Plan some fun stuff

Within reason, plan some events for fun. A trip to Six Flags, miniature golf, the beach, etc.
